BULLSHIT PYRAMID

OF PLAYERS: 3+

EQUIPMENT: Deck of cards

DIFFICULTY RATING: Easy- lie your face off

DANGER RATING: Medium-don't get caught lying

SET-UP:

Using facedown cards, create a pyramid with the base row 5 or 6 cards wide. Then deal four cards to each player. Players must then memorize the cards and place them face down in front of them (in any order). Players may not look at their cards again.

RULES:

Starting with the bottom row of the pyramid, flip one card over. If any player has the revealed card, they may give out one drink. If a player has two of the revealed card they may give out two drinks, etc. At any time, a player may lie and claim to have a card in order to give out more drinks. The bottom row of cards is worth 1x the cards value, the 2nd row of cards is worth 2x the card value, etc.

Players may call Bullshit at any time they believe someone to be lying about what's actually in front of them. If bullshit is called the player must reveal the correct card from in front of them. If lying, the player must drink double what they tried to give out. If bullshit was incorrectly called, the accuser must drink double the original amount. Any time a card is revealed, the player must draw a new card, memorize it, and place it face down in front of them.

Continue to play until the entire pyramid has been revealed.

What were the most total drinks given?
